

Rules for the Online PhD Entrance Examination (RGPV) 2018, Bhopal

1. Candidates for the admission to the PhD program for the academic session 2018-19 must, at the time of application, hold Master's degree with at least 60% marks or an equivalent grade of the University, / a deemed University or any other University incorporated by any law for the time being in force and recognized by the University. However, for SC/ST candidates, 55% marks are required instead of 60%.
2. A candidates shall ordinarily be permitted to work for PhD degree in the subject in which he/she has obtained his Master's or Bachelor degree in Engineering/Technology/Applied Sciences provided that the subject must be one of the subjects included in the Statute of the list of subjects of the University and teaching must be going on in that subject in University Teaching Department/colleges affiliated to the University, which has been recognized as a research centre.
3. The number of seats available for admission to PhD programme shall be decided and notified by the University on its website (www.rgpv.ac.in).
4. The preference will be given to the candidates who have qualified the UGC/CSIR/DST/ National/State Level Fellowship or GATE/GPAT/SLET/Teacher fellowship. (QIP qualified candidates can directly appear for the course work)
5. The duration of Online PhD Entrance Examination (RGPV) 2018 will be of 02 hours (120 minutes).
6. Each question paper will consist of 60 Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) and each question will carry one mark.
7. On-Screen scientific calculator will be available to the candidates to solve the numerical problems.
8. The result of the examination will be flashed on the screen instantly as soon as examination paper will be submitted by the candidate.
9. The candidates shall be admitted to the PhD degree program only through the Online PhD Entrance Examination (RGPV) July 2018 followed by interview for the academic session 2018-19.
10. Qualifying percentage of marks for the Online PhD Entrance Examination (RGPV) 2018 will be 40%.
11. The weightage of the interview marks shall be 20% whereas 60% weightage shall be given to written examination and remaining 20% weightage will be given to the aggregate percentage of qualifying PG examination.
12. Each candidate is required to obtain 50% of marks of total weightage percentage for admission.
13. At the time of interview, the candidates are expected to discuss their research interest / area, choice of supervisors and co-supervisors (if any) and the proposed areas of research.
14. Ordinance No.11 (Ordinance for Doctor of Philosophy) of RGPV which is available on RGPV website can be referred for other information
15. No TA/DA shall be payable to the candidates for appearing in the Online Examination.
16. The entrance examination will be conducted as per the table listed below:
