The RGPV Central library was established in 1986. Library has a sizable collection of more than One lakh books, e-books, e-journals, CD's, E-resources, thesis and print journals on engineering, Science, Social sciences, Pharmacy and Biotechnology. The RGPV library is one of the pillar for the progress of the university. It has a comprehensive database of books on engineering sciences social science and management.

RGPV E-LIBRARY

Under the direction of the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor Prof Sunil Kumar, the Library team worked with Refread to launch **RGPV eLibrary platform**. The platform serves remote access of over 6,00,000 eResources including research journals and theses documents for scholars. The eLibrary has a massive collection of over 22,000 reference and text eBooks from top publishers including IGI Global, Morgan & Claypool, Wiley, Elsevier, McGraw Hill, Cambridge University Press and recently acquired collections of KopyKitab and Pearson. Refread, has curated over 1 Lakh Video lectures and over 16,000 eBook titles from 200+ global platforms and Universities to further broaden the eLibrary collection. Over 1.5 Lakh students have already been registered on the eLibrary.
