Rules for the event:

- ✓ Only UG, PG& Diploma students(Courses: Engineering, Pharma, Architecture) of RGPV affiliated Institutes are allowed to participate in this event.
- ✓ Maximum five teams from one Institute is permitted(First Come first serve basis)
- ✓ Team size should not consist of more than 4 team members. The team should consist of one course only.
- ✓ The entries should be strictly in given format only. Any other format would not be entertained. **The Institute should appoint a faculty-in- charge for this event. The Faculty in charge should send all the entries to CII. No entries from an individual student will be considered.**
- ✓ Parameters on which shortlisting/final evaluation would be done:
 - Uniqueness of idea
 - Problem identified for solving and its magnitude
 - Scalability of idea, Technical Aspects and prospects for commercialization
 - Presentation of the idea and team work involved
