
CHANNELS OF COMMUNICATION

Barriers to Effective Communication

- Improper encoding

Improper Coding

- This barrier is related to improper use of linguistic knowledge i.e improper choice of language and communication.
- The inappropriate use of language leads to misunderstanding and confusion between the sender and the receiver.
- The choice of language and coding leads to comprehension problem between the sender and the receiver.

Bypassing

 In this the gap of emotional and attitudinal understanding between the sender and the receiver is bypassed leading to misrepresentation of the emotional content and the real meaning of the communication.

Frame of reference

- The lack of knowledge on the part of both the sender and the receiver on a particular topic in the context of viewpoint.
- The understanding of the message with different point of view leads to misrepresentation and understanding.

Physical Distraction

- The noise , audio video distraction in oral presentation, improper lighting are few examples of physical distraction.
- The physical distraction leads to loss of hearing and unability to understand the text and content.

Psychological and emotional interference

- The emotional stress and mental stress leads to inability of speech and misrepresentation of ideas.
- The person is unable to make the other person when he is emotionally aroused.
- Lack of knowledge also leads to stress during presentation.

Cultural differences

- The cultural difference and attitude lead to the difference of opinion and misrepresentation of ideas and thoughts.
- The gap in the cultural attitude between the sender and the receiver widens when it is reflected in words.
